LORA J. DEFORE SCHOLARSHIP

The Lora J. DeFore Memorial Endowed Scholarship is a tribute to the popular Mississippi State instructor known for encouraging students to seek demanding internships. She taught in the department of communication for 20 years. She died in 2009 following a long battle with cancer.

Open to MSU communication majors, the scholarship is designed to assist with relocation costs associated with the summer internships, which scholars must secure through individual initiatives. Participants must have completed at least 45 hours of academic coursework with an overall 3.0 (based on a 4.0 scale) grade-point average. To date, eleven scholarships have been awarded.
