

Double Concentrations (or Triple, Etc)

** Students can choose two or more concentrations. Courses required in both concentrations would count in both places and UD of one can count for UD CO electives of the other. This usually comes out to about a semester or so extra or more depending on the concentrations combined. If they choose to do this, they will still get only one degree, but two concentrations will be listed on their transcript.

*** If you are concentrating in Broadcasting and Public Relations, it is not recommended that you take CO 4373 TV Practicum and CO 4813 PR Organizations in the same semester because of the intense work-load in each course.
