



CAPP Reports

Curriculum, Advising and Program Planning

Your CAPP compliance report is a great tool to use before your advising appointment each semester. It lists out your curriculum and highlights the courses you still need for graduation.

To view your CAPP report:

1. Log in to MyState.
2. Click the "Banner" tab.
3. Under the "Academic Records" tab, click "CAPP Compliances."
4. Choose "Generate New Evaluation."

**A "what-if" evaluation can be used if you're considering changing majors or concentration areas within CO.*

Items in green = The requirement is complete.

Items in yellow = These are courses in which you are enrolled.

Items in red = The requirement has not been met.

The blue "Rule is Not Complete" link on the right side of a red item will open a window listing classes that will satisfy that requirement.

Note: When classes are listed as XXXX through YYYY, that means any course in the subject area listed will satisfy the requirement. For example, in the Humanities electives section, REL XXXX-YYYY is listed as an option for a Humanities elective. This simply means that any REL course can be taken as a Humanities elective. However, keep in mind that the 9 hours of Humanities electives must cross two disciplines. Similarly, within the entire Social Science section, students are allowed a maximum of 6 hours in one discipline.

PLEASE NOTE:

Though it is a good indicator of a student's progress toward degree completion, CAPP is not always 100% accurate. It also may not apply or highlight certain university rules that your advisor knows. Please use CAPP as a guide for determining classes you should take, but **always** meet with your advisor to discuss your selections and/or changes to your class schedule.
